Individuals with Symptoms of COVID-19

Student or Staff ill with COVID-19 symptoms

At Home

Parent/ guardian or staff contacts school

Student or Staff:

- Seeks COVID-19 testing through an assessment centre **OR**
- Seeks medical advice for an alternative diagnosis OR
- Self-isolates for 10 days from symptom onset and until they are feeling better, if not tested or an alternative diagnosis is not provided

Parent/guardian or staff follows medical advice. Parents can refer to Facts About COVID-19"What to do if my child is sick"

School prepares student/staff information if records are required for a positive COVID-19 test result



Maintain accurate records of staff and students for the last 30 days including:

- Attendance records
- Class/cohort lists and seating charts
- Before/after school child care lists
- Transportation lists & seating charts
- Updated contact info for students/staff
- Special assignments/programs/activities (e.g. Special Education)
- · Records of essential visitors

At School, Before/After School Program or on Bus (upon arrival)

Alert school staff designated to care for symptomatic student in isolation room and follow school protocol for caring for symptomatic individual ensuring the use of PPE kit



Contact parent/guardian for immediate pick-up. Symptomatic staff are to go home immediately



Any students or staff who are household members of the symptomatic individual must be dismissed and remain home while the symptomatic individual is awaiting test results or receives an alternative medical diagnosis



Student or Staff:

- Seeks COVID-19 testing through an assessment centre OR
