Student/Staff Deemed a Probable Case of COVID-19

Probable Case is a high-risk contact who develops COVID-19 symptoms and has not been tested or is awaiting test results for COVID-19.

Durham Region Health Department (DRHD) is notified of a probable case and contacts the staff or student (or student's parent/guardian) to conduct case and contact management. District boards and schools are required to post information to their websites if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 that involves a student or staff member in a school setting. In the interests of privacy, information provided to school communities will not identify the student or staff member that has received a positive COVID-19 test. DRHD will post outbreaks on their COVID-19 dashboard/website.

DRHD has provided school boards with information that can be used to communicate with their school community. The purpose of this communication would be to provide reassurance and guidance and would **<u>not</u>** provide specific information or identifying details.

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
